You are aware that the Ministry of Rural Development (vide L-11033/7/2015-RE-VII, Dated 5th Feb,2016) has communicated its Action Plan on Social Audit to the State and has been requesting to ensure the compliance of activities and timeline mentioned in the Action Plan. However no significant progress has been made so far in this regards. To ensure the effective implementation of Social Audit and Mahatma Gandhi NREGA, the State Government has to institutionalize the social audit process and ensure the following on immediate basis.

- iv) To set up SAU as an independent registered society which is financially, functionally and administratively independent of implementation agency of the State.
- To constitute the governing body in the prescribed manner. It is mandatory to have 3 V) representatives from Civil Society Organizations, Academic and Training Institutions, working in the state or outside, having long standing eminent citizens with long standing experience in working with issues related to transparency and public accountability. The State Government is requested to ensure the same.
- To expedite the recruitment at State and District level. The Ministry has already vi) released the fund for staffing in social audit unit. The State Government is requested to communicate the dates of recruitment and State level training which will be held as per TISS Curriculum.
- 2. Since the Ministry has planned to start the training of the Master trainers from 6th of September, 2016 for all the States, it will be effective and relevant if SAU is completely institutionalized for the capacity building of the core staff. I request your assistance and cooperation in ensuring the same.
