**Subject: Expediting Aadhaar based payments through banks under MGNREGA.**

Dear Chief Secretary,

You are aware that the expeditious use of digital payment options may help to achieve 100% conversion of Government - citizen transactions to digital platform and transform India into less cash economy. The Aadhaar Payment Bridge System (APBS) and Aadhaar Enabled Payment Systems (AEPS) are one of the available options which the Ministry of Rural Development is focusing on.

2. In line with this, your State has earlier been requested for expediting the Aadhaar based payments through Banks for all active workers under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA.

3. As per MIS (NREGASoft), there are total lakh active workers under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA in your state; out of which lakh Aadhaar numbers of the active workers have been seeded in NREGASoft and conversion of active workers for Aadhaar based payments (ABP) has been achieved.

4. You may also be aware that under MGNREGA the ABP has to be done for all active workers at the earliest. In order to achieve this, you are requested to ensure that the issues are regularly taken up with the banks in the SLBC meetings and with the Lead District Managers (LDMs).

5. In light of the points made above, you are requested to monitor this aspect of work at regular intervals.
